



## **Local musical artist Alice Lui is tuning up for all return to her homeland shows at Dada**

**(Hong Kong, 17 October 2011)** - This autumn, Dada Bar + Lounge (Dada) will be staging the latest of its many musical coups by enticing talented local bandleader Alice Lui back to Hong Kong from San Francisco. Once the Territory's youngest ever bandleader, Alice first began wowing the local music lovers by ripping up venues with the famed all-girl band "The Angels" back in the 1970s. On 27 November, Sunday, you will see Alice and her guest band "Kongo Rikishi Zero", turning the clock back to those younger and more carefree times. Kicking off at 8:30pm and taking in everything from classic 50s hits to current sounds right through to midnight, Dada's one-off **"Alice in Motherland 2011" Mini Concert** show promises to be a real blast for music lovers.

### **Everything you wanted to know about Alice but were afraid to ask**

A gifted and versatile singer and keyboardist, Alice became a professional muso after high school and went on tour singing all over Southeast Asia with all girls band "The Angels". At the tender age of 19, she became the youngest female bandleader in Hong Kong Mocambo Night Club. Within a couple of years, Alice moved musical bases to San Francisco and formed another band, "Alice and the Wave". Over the years, this multi-lingual combo built up such strong word of mouth. Hip US radio station FM 96.5 KOIT raved they were "Sensation from the Orient".

Alice comes to Dada having joined stars such as Richard Elliott, ("Best Wind Player" award winner at the American Smooth Jazz Awards) in earning standing ovations at this October's Yosemite International Jazz Festival, the biggest musical event in Central California. In doing so, she became the first ever Chinese musical artist to perform at this hugely popular highlight of the West Coast jazz calendar.

Taking to the stage at 8:30pm, Alice and her guest band the magnificent "Kongo Rikishi Zero", Esan Shi (guitar), Alex Katsumata, (bass), Fernando Nohra (drums), will be playing a veritable smorgasbord of music. If you love smooth jazz, raw-edged rock, Latin, disco, blues or ballads from any era from the 1950s to today, **"Alice in Motherland 2011"** is the show you won't want to miss.

As Alice says, "Having just achieved a milestone in the US, I can think of no better way to celebrate than to return home to Hong Kong and catch up with some old friends. Everyone tells me that Dada is a fantastically cozy venue and I can't wait to fill everyone's evening with love, fun, memories and warmth".
